

Attention All Cub Scout Packs!!!

Boston Museum of Science

Spring Date: Saturday, April 26, 2014

It's time to start planning for the 2014 Overnight Program at the Boston Museum of Science. The cost is \$58.00 per person. (Please note: The Museum charges a minimal fee for people parking in the Museum garage during the Overnight.) **The event is limited to CUB SCOUTS and ADULTS only. Siblings and unregistered youth cannot attend – no exceptions!** To apply for this trip/drawing, please follow the guidelines below. **Please note: The Packs who did not attend in April of 2013 (because of the lockdown situation in Boston at that time) will need to follow these same guidelines; but will be given first preference before the drawing is done. The Packs who did attend in 2013 are, respectfully, asked not to apply this year as space will be more limited for Packs who were not selected in the drawing last year.**

Application Procedure

Each Pack must submit a deposit of \$15 for each person who plans to attend. Please send a check made payable to Pine Tree Council, along with the registration coupon below. Phone applications **will not** be accepted.

All applications must be received at the Pine Tree Council by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 13, 2013. Please do not request reservations for more slots than you actually plan to use (**for those who are selected, deposits are non-refundable.**) A drawing will be held on Thursday, November 14, 2013. Those who were selected from the drawing will be notified, and the remaining payment will be due at the Pine Tree Council by Friday, January 24, 2014. Any reserved slots not paid in full by this date will be lost and offered to those on the waiting list (**again, the initial deposit for those selected is non-refundable.**) Those Packs not selected will also be notified and deposits will be returned.

Once participants are confirmed, the Pine Tree Council is required to pay for those spaces. It is the policy of the Boston Museum of Science not to grant refunds to anyone who does not participate in the Camp-In, unless the MUSEUM cancels the event.
