Starting January 14th, 2014 at 6 pm at the Freeport Fire/Rescue Station (4 Main Street, Freeport), and continuing for the next four Tuesday nights, we will be offering the FEMA Citizens Emergency Readiness Training (<http://cts.vresp.com/c/?PineTreeCouncilBSA/d3cbf9c8f8/933ba4fd8b/a17dd867fe>) for the first 30 people who sign up, FREE OF CHARGE! This course is available to Boy Scouts who are First Class or above, Venture Scouts, and Explorer Scouts. This training will teach the Scouts and leaders who participate about emergency preparedness training, disaster relief, First Aid, AED use, and much more. Those

who complete the course will receive FIRST AID, CPR, & CERT certificates from FEMA, and Emergency Preparedness & First Aid Merit Badges.

The course will be headed up by Deputy Fire Chief for the Town of Freeport, Paul Conley, and his team of instructors from various departments in the State of Maine emergency services community.
